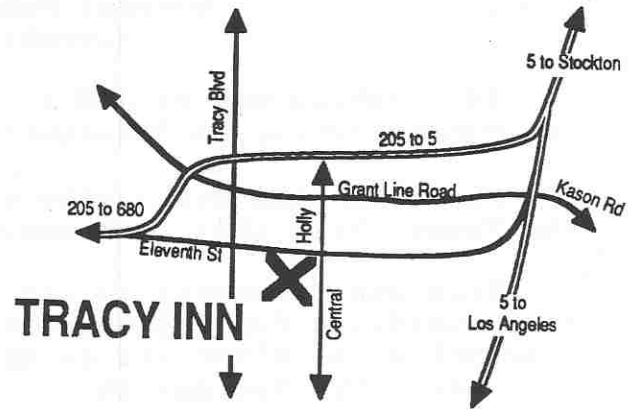
The club B. of D. chose this event for our January ride and we hope to entice all our members to show up on the 28th of January for a day of riding and looking at new wheels and products.

Ron gave some late rally costs and ending profit report for the Beemer Bash 1988, and announced upcoming rallies.

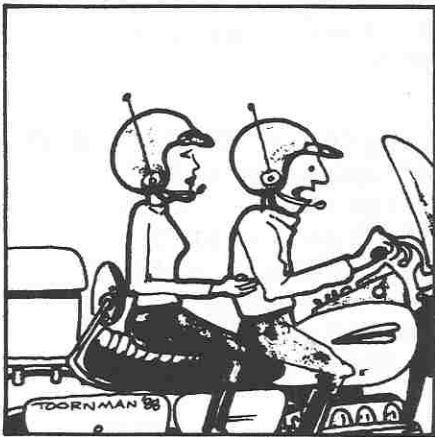

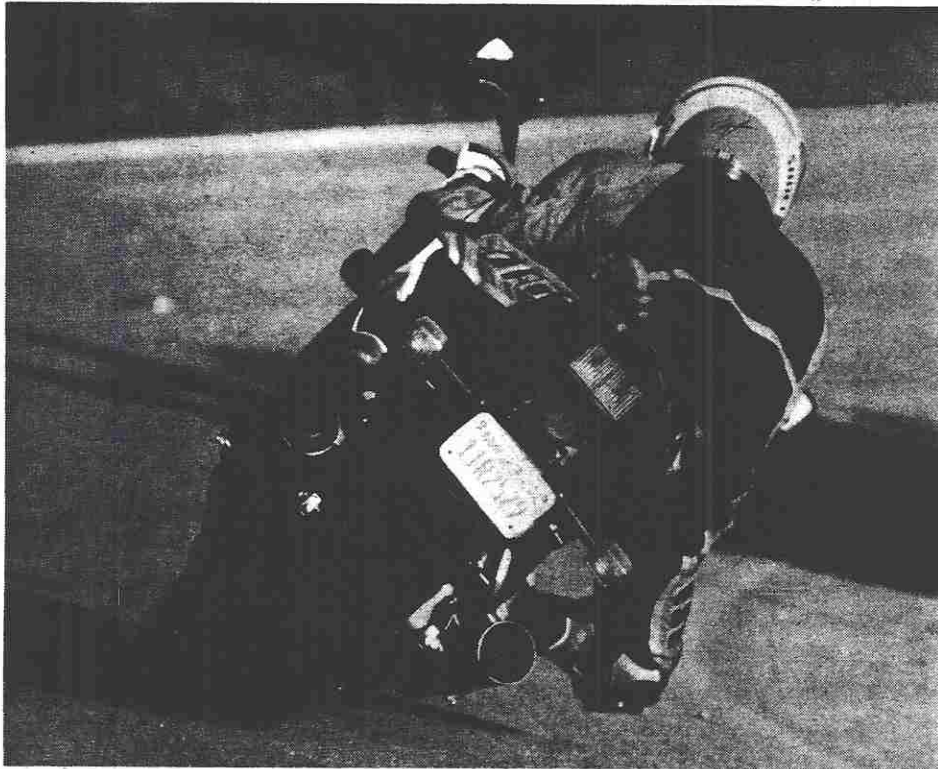

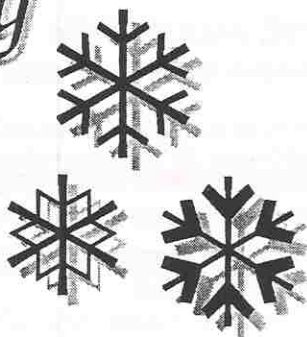
